

## Author or Publisher Wishes to Submit a Book

How does an author or publisher submit a book for Accelerated Reader™ quiz consideration?

Our goal is to offer quizzes for books that are likely to be in many school libraries. To help us in attaining that goal, we use selection criteria similar to the criteria that school librarians use. We consider:

- Books that are national award winners
- Books receiving multiple positive reviews (from national publications such as *School Library Journal*, *Horn Book*, *Kirkus*, *Library Media Connection*, *VOYA*, and *Booklist*)
- Books on recommended reading lists (such as State Lists)
- Books written by popular authors
- Books in a continuing popular series such as *Magic Tree House* or *Harry Potter*
- Books that are suggested by a number of different schools across the nation (through our quiz store on the Web)

Availability and popularity of each book are also considered. The final decision to select a book for quiz development is at the sole discretion of Renaissance Learning™. Due to various factors, some books cannot support a quality quiz. An author or publisher is welcome to submit two copies of a book to be considered for an Accelerated Reader quiz. Books should be sent, with a cover letter, to the attention of Title Selection Coordinator, Renaissance Learning, Inc., 2911 Peach Street, Wisconsin Rapids, WI 54494. The cover letter should include information about each book’s awards, positive reviews, and distribution (i.e. whether the book is available through major school library suppliers).

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
